## A letter from your Town Administrator

Dear Boonville Residents,

Happy New Year! Since the fall edition of the newsletter, we have made a few changes with our quarterly newsletter! You will notice we have added a section called "News from your Local Emergency Services" which will include helpful tips and information from the Fire and Police Departments.

As we head into the new year, the Town of Boonville will begin its preparation of the

fiscal year 2019-2020 budget. The process of creating the Town's budget starts with a Town Board member retreat where the Board members set short-term and long-term goals and priorities. From there, a series of budget workshops will be held with the Town Board members to consider budget requests. These budget workshops are open meetings. The public is invited to attend and observe the process.

By June 1st I will present the Town Board members with a proposed budget and budget message in accordance with North Carolina General Stat-

ute 159-11. The proposed budget will represent the Town's commitment to the identified goals and priorities set forth by the Board of Commissioners.

This year we plan to clarify the language on the utility bills to eliminate confusion.

**RECYCLE RIGHT.** Things you can do to ensure quality material is recycled:



**DO NOT INCLUDE:** Food waste, plastic bags, polystyrene foam cups & containers, hangers or hazardous waste

- Paper and cardboard must be dry and free of food debris.
- Tissues, paper towels or other paper that has been in contact with food is not acceptable.
- Make sure food contamination and caps are removed from cans and plastics and all containers are empty.
- Separate plastic lids from plastic bottles (often made from different materials).
- Do not place medical waste (needles, catheters or lancets) into the recycling containers.
