

## WHAT'S GOING ON IN BOONVILLE!

Boonville was awarded \$3 million dollars in ARPA funds from the State of NC. With these funds, we have almost completed a water line replacement project on Canary Avenue, Cardinal Avenue and Baptist Church Road. The contractor will return to kill the old lines and repair some paving issues.

Also, with these funds, we have been conducting an inventory of our sewer lines with an imaging camera. KRG Company has been doing heavy cleaning and completing an inventory of needs with our sewer collection system. Once completed, we will begin repairing some of these lines with pipe replace, pipe bursting and slip lining methods.

The last portion of these funds were to be used for our Wastewater Treatment Plant update, but with the sewer lines in the condition they are we will likely use those funds to address water infiltration issues.

The Town of Boonville did receive a \$3.7 million grant from the State of NC which will overhaul aging parts of our Wastewater Treatment Plant.

In this last budget passed by the State of NC, \$3 million was awarded to the Town of Boonville for more water and sewer infrastructure projects.

The Town Board approved funds to repair aging sidewalks around town. This work has begun on the west side of town and will continue until completed.

The Intersection Project being completed by the NC DOT, is slated to be bid in the first quarter of 2024. They have begun surveying in this area.

The Zirrus Fiber Project should begin in the first quarter of 2024, as well. We are excited to see this project get going.
