Commissioner Matthews stated that item D was worded incorrectly. She asked the Board members to consider adding two-family dwelling with multi-family dwelling and to add RA and R-15 to R-10.

Mrs. Jessica Cox, 108 Wren Ave, thanked the Board members for picking up bulk items monthly instead of semi-annually.
