In attendance: Mayor Rusty Hunter, Commissioners Bill Florence, Janet Matthews, William Paul Baity, and Gerald Brown. Also in attendance were Finance Officer/Town Clerk Kim Wells and Public Works Director Jeff Jones.

Mayor Hunter called the meeting to order at 7:22pm.

Mayor Hunter stated that Item II. D. on the agenda would now read, "Move multi-family dwelling and two-family dwelling from M-1 to RA, R-10 and R-15 in the Zoning Ordinance and Town Code of Ordinances with the same codes.
