The following were in attendance at the 6/11/26 recessed meeting: Mayor Megan Sizemore, Mayor Pro-tem Greg Wagoner, Commissioners William Paul Baity, Rob Dixon, Zane Green, and Kristin Johnson. Also in attendance were Finance Officer/Town Clerk Kim Wells, Police Chief Jeff Hobson, and Public Works Director Brian Higgins.

Mayor Sizemore called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

The Board members discussed various items. It was the consensus of the Board members to continue with the BCBS renewal but to ask the NC League of Municipalities next year for a quote to compare the two insurances.

It was the consensus of the Board members to wait to discuss a longevity bonus for employees at a later date.

The Board members discussed unused holiday time. It was the consensus of the Board members to create a Holiday Payout Policy and adopt it at the next regular meeting. Commissioner Baity motioned to pay out anything over 144 holiday hours as of 7/1/26. Mayor Pro-tem Wagoner seconded, and the motion passed with a 5-0 vote.

Mayor Sizemore referenced a need to meet with a potential new town attorney. A Special Meeting will be announced and posted at a later date.

Mayor Sizemore referenced the damage at 160 Speas Ave. Discussion followed. It was the consensus of the Board members not to have any further discussion of this issue.

Mayor Pro-tem Wagoner motioned to go in to closed session (per NCGS 143-318.11(a) (6)). Commissioner Dixon seconded, and the motion passed with a 5-0 vote at 8:05p.m.

Commissioner Green motioned to return to open session. Mayor Pro-tem Wagoner seconded, and the motion passed at 9:05 p.m. with a 5-0 vote.

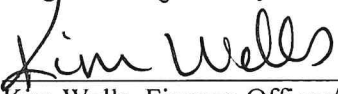
